Fees and Tuition

Annual Registration Fee: \$100 (non-refundable)

Part Time Preschool

3 days - \$120 / week

4 / 5 days - \$140 / week

The Preschool Program

The center is located in the St. Thomas More School building. This preschool program is multiage for children from three to five years of age. The child must be three years of age by September 30 and toilet trained to enroll for the school year beginning in August. Children enrolled in the Child Development Center will have preference for enrollment in the St. Thomas More Kindergarten Program.

Certified, licensed teachers experienced in early childhood education will provide a curriculum that will include religion, development of gross and fine motor skills, music and movement, arts and crafts, nature and science activities, and readiness skills in math, reading and language. Enrichment activities will include individualized music and computer exploration.

The center's school year is from August through May. The St. Thomas More School calendar, in regards to holidays, vacations, and teacher professional development days, will be followed.
