MISSION STATEMENT

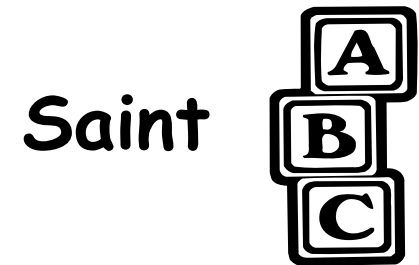
At St. Thomas More Preschool

Fees and Tuition

Annual Registration Fee:
\$100.00 (non-refundable)

The Preschool Program

The center is located in the St. Thomas More School building. This preschool program is for children from three to five years of age. The child must be three years of age by September 30th and toilet trained to enroll for the school year beginning in August. Children enrolled in the Preschool will have preference for enrollment in the St. Thomas More Kindergarten program.

Certified teachers, experienced in early childhood education, provide a comprehensive curriculum. Kindergarten readiness skills in math, reading, and language arts are emphasized, along with the development of gross and fine motor skills. Other activities include music and movement, arts and crafts, computer exploration, and nature and science activities. Christian values are interwoven in the curriculum.

The center's school year is from August through June.
