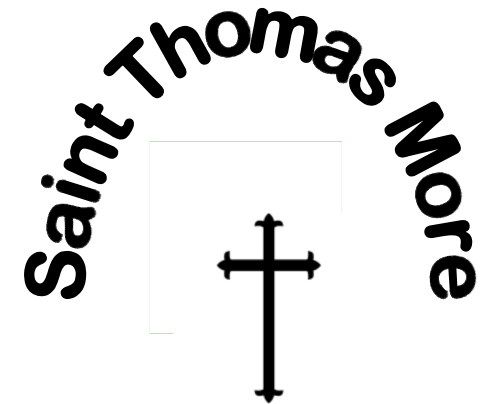

## TUITION AND FEES

Registration Fee     \$200.00 per child  
(non-refundable)

### Tuition Plan A

For those not attending Mass, not using Offertory envelopes totaling \$500 per year, and not participating in the Manna Program:

**\$3800.00 per child**

### Tuition Plan B

For active and practicing Catholic families:

**One child: \$3,000.00**

**Two children: \$5,600.00**

**Three or more children: \$8,200.00**

“Active and practicing Catholic families” are those who attend Mass regularly and contribute at least \$10.00 weekly in the Sunday Offertory (annual total of \$500.00 in Offertory from May 1 to April 30. Active and practicing Catholic families also qualify for a Parish Scholarship from Sunday Offertory (approximately \$800.00 per child - as evidenced in the tuition plan).

### Tuition Plan C

For active and practicing Catholic families (see Tuition Plan B) who also participate fully in our Manna and School Fundraising Programs:

**One child: \$2,800.00**

**Two children: \$5,200.00**

**Three or more children: \$7,600.00**

St. Thomas More Parish offers the Manna Program for those who choose to participate. It is a scholarship fundraiser. Families who purchase at least \$2,500.00 of certificates annually (May 1 to April 30) and submit \$300.00 in school fundraising sales receive approximately \$200.00 in scholarship per child as a share of the program’s profits. A Fundraising Opt-Out Option is available for a one-time fee of \$150.

- √ St. Thomas More School is licensed by the State of Ohio to educate children in Preschool through Grade Eight.
- √ 100% of teachers in the Day School have B.A.’s and ALL teachers are certified by the State of Ohio.
- √ 30% of teachers hold Master’s degrees.
- √ Individualized instruction in all classes.
- √ All students in Preschool through Grade 8 receive weekly instruction in Art, Music, Computers, and Physical Education.
- √ All educational areas are networked, have Internet access, and wireless capabilities.
- √ On the average, 96% of eighth graders attend Catholic High Schools.
- √ 343 Students enrolled in Pre K through Gr. 8
- √ School Day is from 7:55 AM to 2:25 PM
- √ Before Care Services available at 7:00 AM;  
After Care available from 2:25 to 6:00 PM.
