In addition to this, it is a great idea to practice addition and subtraction facts for a few minutes each day or at least a couple times per week! These facts will greatly help them in first grade!

### A Look at Curriculum

**Math**- Counting 1-100, by 2's even & odd, 10's, 5's, 100's, ordering numbers, graphing, geometry, least to greatest, telling time, money, dividing solids, doubles facts, addition & subtraction, doubles plus 1, adding/subtracting two digits. Sums of 10

**LA & Phonics**-Verbs ending in; -ing, -ed, &-s, Nouns, Contractions, Possessives, silent letters, Irregular vowels, short vowels, long vowels, vowel pairs, compound words, Pronouns, homophones, reading fluency, etc

**Social Studies** – Everything Changes, Good Citizens, Maps, Rules and Laws

**Writing**- Forming complete sentences, Personal Narratives, Descriptions, Summarizing, Research Reports, Creative Stories, Letter Writing.

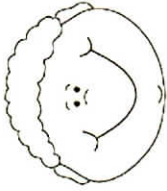

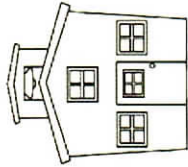
It is recommended that students read at least 3-5 books this summer if not more. When they do, please have them fill in the attached story map that highlights important story elements.
